Smaller models must still use the hot pit and opening at the South end. Pilots of these large models must make all flying pilots aware of taxiing South for take-off. Enlisting a helper and flight box place holder is encouraged.

**Activities during Open Cockpit include:**

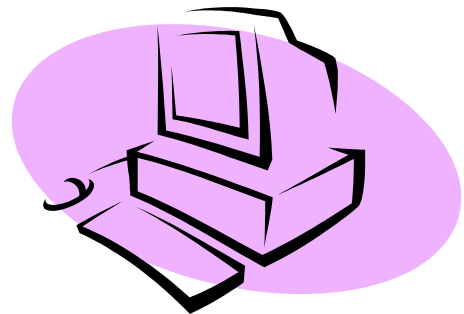
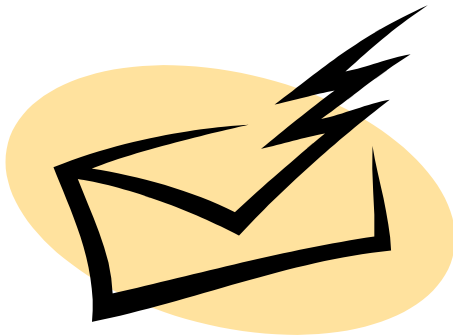
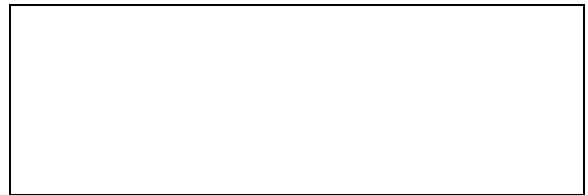
