**Activities during Open Cockpit include:**

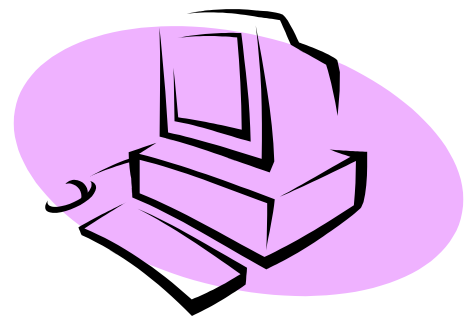
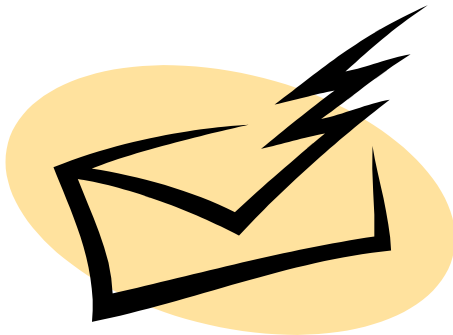
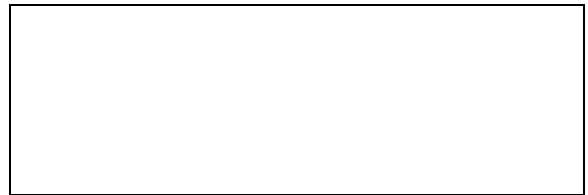
