#### Field Report:

Members put up the shade netting, many thanks to those who helped.

#### **Safety Report:**

Frequency pins continue to be a hot topic. Please take your AMA card off the rack when you return the pin. You should only have a pin when you are prepping to fly or actually flying. If you are going to fly in 10 or 15 minutes you should not have a pin –put it back when you are done flying!

Please don't hog the tables – they are only for set-up, repair and disassembly of your model, not for storage. Your planes are much safer on the ground where they will not get blown off by the wind. Have a thought for others that would like to use the tables as well!

Steve Hoyt reported on a serious injury at South County – someone started a large (Giant Scale) model without the proper restraint or a helper – the throttle was either reversed or inadvertently

left at high throttle, when the engine started it got away and the 26" carbon-fiber prop chewed up the legs of another member, cutting him to the bone. The moral of the story is to either use the starting benches or the restraint if the airplane is too large for the bench.

Following that thought – do not leave your airplane and starting gear in the hot pit area. If you are done flying, remove your gear and airplane to the normal pit area.



We had a situation last week at the field where a plane after landing and taxing to the pit area went to full throttle and scooted across the field into the pickle weed. There was no one hurt and the plane was un damaged. The incident was caused by the pilot turning the transmitter off before turning the plane off. The pilot was using a 2.4 system and the fail safe (Binding) was also not set up properly. **NEVER**LOOSE CONTROL OF YOUR AIRPLANE- START UP Turn your transmitter on first then the plane. SHUT DOWN turn the plane off first and then the transmit-
