Safety Report:

Art Vargas brought up some items of concern to the club. He indicated that sometimes people put equipment on the impound table, take a frequency pin and then go and fly repeatedly without putting the pin back.

This is inconsiderate of other people who may be waiting to fly. He also mentioned that people will take the 2.4 frequency pins and keep them on their persons when they are not actually flying. The expectation is that people should only have the pins on their persons when they are actually flying or actually preparing to fly. 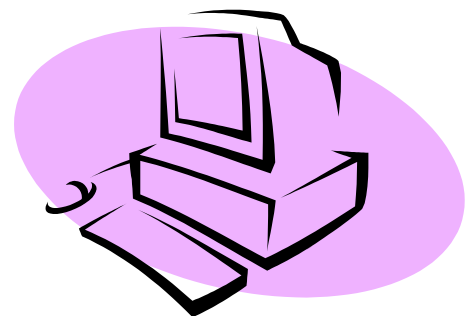
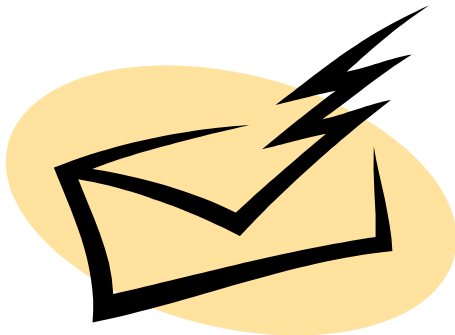
