BOARD MEETING:

Treasurer's Report:

Safety Report:

Norm Coates said he has seen members arming their planes on the outside tables and wants to remind all members to use the pit area to arm your planes. This is a safety issue and we don't want to have any accidents.

Steve Hoyt added that for safety, fliers going out into the open area to recover a plane, should go with another person. He said there are still some unmarked holes and a lot of water out there. We should also be aware that there are a lot of ticks this season, so check

yourself when you come back from the tall grass areas. Use deets to help prevents getting ticks and other insects on you.

Field Report:

Norm Coates said that Brady Deitrick has asked him to mow the trails next week. They will be having a work get together on Wednesday the 14th and Friday the 16th to mow the trails, kill weeds and remove broken pipe near the drainage ditch. The more members that can help the faster the project will go. Starting time to be announced.

Art Vargas said that he recently sprayed weeds along the runway.

David Ching said you can use a mixture of vinegar and salt to kill weeds that works as good as Roundup.

Hoyt added that he will be calling the county to see if they can clean out the drainage pipe to help the flow and remove the water faster.

Old Business:

Hoyt said that Utley is trying to make a deposit for the Christmas Party, but our second Saturday may be reserved already. Jim is looking into keeping the date and will get back to us.

We are still waiting to hear if we will be getting another container for the field. This process takes awhile.

New Business:

Scott Clinton asked about the possibility of having a cross wind runway. Utley said it would take too much dirt and would have to be compacted.

Hoyt said he is also a member of the Bayside RC Club in Newark. He said he tries to bring back ideas to help our club. He asked what can we do to make our club better? He added that Burt Rosensweig will be working with Jim Utley to see what our club needs are financially regarding our current membership. He will report back to the board with his findings and make suggestions for the clubs future.

David Ching asked what the clubs plans are for the unfinished Heli pad. Can we finish it or use it for other things such as car racing etc.? No answers were given at this time.

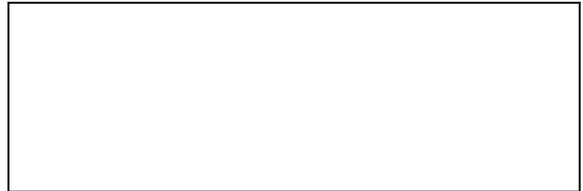
