Safety Committee Report:

Read the Field Rules! When you taxi back after landing (if you are still able to taxi) then taxi past the opening to the hot pit and execute a 180 – do not ever point your airplane towards the opening.

Also – the first maneuver after taking off is a left turn – away from the pit area. No low passes over the runway – always beyond the far edge of the runway

No nitro or gas engines prior to 9AM.

Those are the rules you accepted – please abide by them!

Spring is the season for ticks and mosquitoes. They are a hazards until October.

Be sure to wear high boots if you have to retrieve your plane in the marshes.

When entering or leaving the field be sure to spin the combination so that it is not close to what our combination is – and be sure to not skip any locks in the chain.

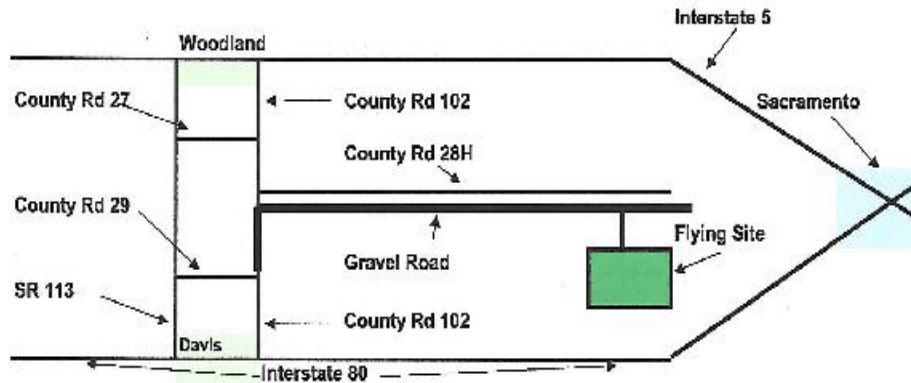

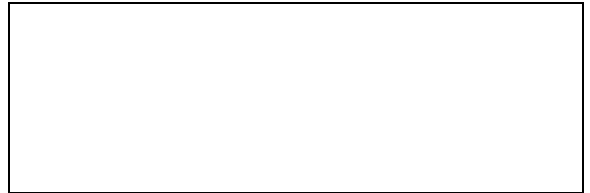
